It's also about the feeling of being trapped in adolescence and how it can feel hopeless, lonely, scary and painful to step into something new and unknown.

FIREFLIES A composition celebrating hope, even when everything feels hopeless.

THE OWL The wholesome one. A composition about having the confidence and courage to believe in yourself and that you can take on the world and get through the hardship of life. The importance of having someone you care about who also cares about you,

someone who can make you realise you don't have to go through the struggles of life alone. **STRANGER** When you think you know someone and realise that knowing someone to the core is an impossible mission. When they do something you never knew them to be capable of.
